Nature Based Approaches for Climate Resilient Infrastructure

SYNOPSIS

Building on discussions held at the recent Convention on Biological Diversity COP 14 in Sharm El Sheik, this event will focus on illustrations of how various natural and nature-based features are being employed to build climate resiliency into infrastructure investments. Key questions for discussion will include:

- How can maintaining healthy ecosystems – such as forests, wetlands, or coral reefs – provide valuable and cost-effective climate resiliency benefits as a complement or alternative to engineered infrastructure?
- What principles are emerging for planning ecologically sustainable and climate resilient engineered infrastructure, including through hybrid approaches incorporating the conservation or rehabilitation of ecosystems?
